The tour includes visit of Nepal's capital city, Kathmandu and its heritages, and the beautiful lakeside town of Pokhara, wildlife safari in Nepal's plains, then over to Bhutan to explore its interesting culture, people, landscapes and many more.

The Bhutanese call their country Druk Yul or the Land of the Thunder Dragon, in which you will get a chance to see everything that the Bhutan has to offer including remote and dramatic monasteries of Bhutan that rule in the pristine and intact Bhutanese landscape.

Above all, you will get a chance to interact with the local people and to witness the way of life in Bhutan and Nepal and you will return to Nepal again for your return flight to home.

The Nepal and Bhutan tour is leisure tour and you do not need to have any experience or physically fit as this is land tour by private vehicle with local tour leader and suitable for any time of the year and any ages of people.
