Best Season: March-June and September-December (Autumn - best weather at Muktinath):

This is the peak season in Nepal, neither too cold nor too hot.

Our journey to Muktinath begins with a travel to Pokhara by road from Kathmandu and have a chance to ride the Manakamana cable car en route. We fly you to Jomsom from Pokhara for the short trek to Muktinath, where we allow you time to luxuriate in a holy bathe as well as committing to worship and darshan.

Day to Day Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival and transfer to Hotel in Kathmandu

Day 02: Kathmandu sightseeing.

Day 03: Drive/Fly to Pokhara.

Day 04: Fly to Jomsom then drive to Muktinath, perform puja in the Temple and drive back to Jomsom.

Day 05: Fly back to Pokhara & Pokhara Sightseeing.

Day 06: Drive / Fly back to Kathmandu.
